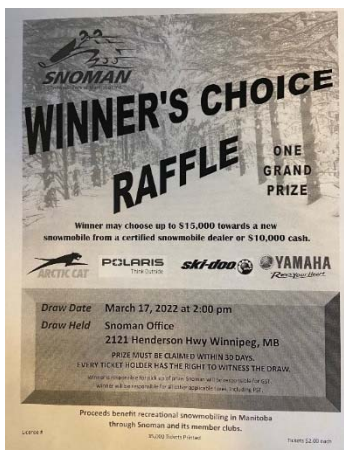
All of trail 765 will be a **ONE-WAY** trail along the north and south ditch of Highway 44
