



NOTICE TO SNOWMOBILERS

from the Eastman SnoPals

Trail 768 is an important trail for our club as it is the only access route to Lac du Bonnet from the east. One mile of this trail east of the Winnipeg River runs along a very narrow ditch adjacent to private farmland.

We do not have permission to put our trail on the adjacent private land. Every year we use hundreds of feet of snow fence, countless posts and signs in an attempt to direct the snowmobile traffic onto our trail. Yet every year snowmobilers go around the fence, disobey the signs and ride on the private property.

This is very disrespectful and is in fact TRESPASSING!

As a snowmobile club it is our mission to maintain trails and to be respectful of our neighbouring landowners.

It is **YOUR** responsibility as a snowmobiler to obtain prior permission before going on private land, failing to do so is trespassing and subject to prosecution under the Manitoba Trespass Act.

This farmland is NOT crown land, please stay on the trail and respect the landowner.

Manitoba Trespass Act: (Excerpt)

Trespassing Offence

1(1) Subject to subsections (1.1) to (5), a person commits an offence who

(a) Enters on any of the following lands or premises without permission of the owner, tenant or occupier

(vi) Lands or premises used for the cultivation of crops, the grazing or feeding of animals, the raising of birds or fish or beekeeping:

Respect our landowners, stay on the trails.
